LEVIN ROTARY TO BUILD CHARITY HOUSE



This style of house will spring up at 156 Oxford Street (south entrance to Levin) next to the old National Bank Building.



This house was built using the same plan. It is 107sqm, making it relocatable in one piece.

Levin Rotary is about to embark on one of its' largest community projects. The Club has secured the use of a site at 156 Oxford Street where a relocatable 107 sqm house will be built.

Starting this month the high quality, purpose built house will feature 3 bedrooms, an en suite, spacious living area, modern kitchen and a separate laundry. Upon completion the house will be auctioned by Property Brokers, on site. The project is being completed as the result of a collaboration between

local people and businesses donating their time, expertise and materials

Proceeds will go to the Horowhenua based Te Hinaki Education Trust. Its objective is to give every Horowhenua primary or secondary school child, equitable access to the digital environment.

Families will be able to purchase digital equipment through the Trust with minimal deposit and at an affordable pay back rate. Already 150 chromebooks have been distributed to Foxton Beach School, Shannon School, Horowhenua College and Waiopahu College.

Levin Rotary is appealing to the community to get behind the project by supporting the auction and by offering materials, chattels, expertise, time, money and items which can be raffled to raise funds. Rotary would love to secure the services of a building transport firm, so transport could be included in the price realised at auction.
