The Kapiti Citizens Advice Bureau volunteers work from 9am - 4pm weekdays assisting a huge variety of people to solve a huge variety of problems. The service is free, and it is for anyone.

In the last 12 months the CAB team has logged 3,500 queries. From something as simple as contact details to very complex problems requiring hours of research, the volunteers are trained and well equipped to provide advice and accurate information.

The CAB sources information from local clubs, family support and social services. They handle housing and tenancy queries, consumer rights, employment as well family and relationship issues.



In March the Citizens Advice Bureau Kapiti held a display in Coastlands Mall as part of the CAB Awareness Week. Volunteers Elizabeth and Brian talk with a someone seeking advice from CAB.

Every Tuesday and Friday from 11.30am - 1.30pm the CAB provide a Justice of the Peace service. Whitireia Community Law Centre lawyers visit the CAB Coastlands office on a regular basis to offer half an hour of free legal advice. Appointments are made through the CAB.

The Bureau has been authorised by Immigration New Zealand to assist new migrants with information. Free workshops are held for those new to New Zealand covering employment, immigration, education, housing and accessing health services as well as anything else they may want to know.



Tony has been a volunteer with CAB Kapiti for 3 years, and he is working alongside Marilyn who has been a volunteer for a year. The CAB office carries information on just about everything.


