Gold Coast NZ Rock 'N' Roll Club formed in 1988. Television programmes such as Happy Days and American Graffiti created a resurgence of interest in the 1950's and 60's Rock 'n' Roll era.

Club nights are held from 7.30pm every Wednesday, mid January to mid December, at the Paraparaumu Memorial Hall, Tatanekai Street, Paraparaumu.

From January, the third Saturday, every second month, is a themed "hop" where the

glitz and the glad rags come out as the hall is transformed to match the theme. Rock N Roll is a great way to keep fit, have fun and meet new people. You don't have to have a partner to join in. Dancers into their 80's take to the floor, junior members under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

Dance classes for beginners are held throughout the year. The next one starts on 19 February 2020. Experienced dance coaches hold classes once a week for five weeks. In the meantime anyone is welcome to attend weekly Club nights.

Some members travel around the country to compete, while others dance for the sheer pleasure. There's no need to buy special clothing – comfortable shoes without heels and flexible clothing is all that's required. High heels are not permitted.

Annual membership is \$25.00, and includes weekly newsletters. Members pay \$2 to attend club nights, non-members \$4. Your first night is free and \$30.00 covers the five week beginners course.
