Their work includes creating awareness and understanding of elder abuse including neglect, social isolation, physical and emotional abuse, and loneliness througout Horowhenua.

Seniors can access FREE and CONFIDENTIAL services provided by ACH:

These include:

- Elder Abuse Service: Intervention where a senior's safety or wellbeing is at risk. Professional staff devlop a structure that enables assessment, support and monitoring with a goal to prevent harm and re-victimisation.
- Accredited Visiting Service: Volunteers
 visit seniors who may be lonely, socially
 isolated, or just to share an hour or so
 each week for a chat.
- Social Connection Service:
 Community projects offering
 senior involvement ie:
 "Steady as you Go©" a
 unique community based
 falls prevention programme
 currently in Foxton and Levin,
 "Nat & Chat" Seniors share morning
 tea on the last Thursday of the month,
 often with guest speakers.
 Everyone is welcome.

"Stay Safe" workshops: Workshops for senior road users refreshing driving skills and road code knowlege. Information Resources - Providing written material e.g. pamphlets and resources, some in collaboration with Horowhenua District Council.

- "60 Activities for the over 60's" booklet.
- Education: Public seminars on positive ageing, how to avoid scams and other financial abuse etc
- Representation and advice: On behalf of senior's issues to local influential groups e.g. District Council.
