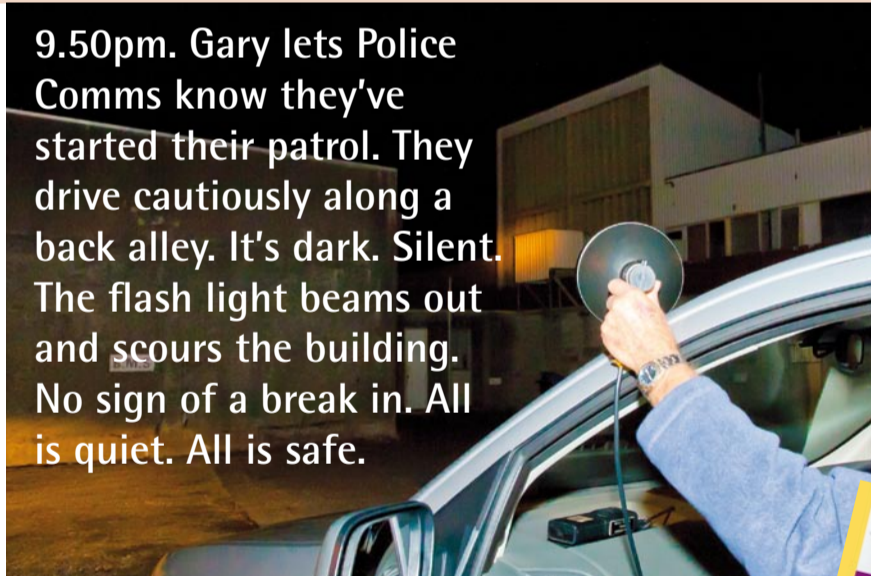
## Levin Community patrol



For 17 years, volunteers from the Levin Community Patrol have been working with police to help keep our community safe.

You may not know it, but almost every night of the year, two volunteer patrollers cruise the streets and back alleys of Levin looking for signs of trouble. These "eyes and ears" of the community alert police if they see break-ins, people in trouble, or just something out of the ordinary.



9.50pm. Gary lets Police Comms know they've started their patrol. They drive cautiously along a back alley. It's dark. Silent. The flash light beams out and scours the building. No sign of a break in. All is quiet. All is safe.
