TE HORO HALL & COUNTRY MARKET

While many rural settlements have lost their community halls, Te Horo Hall is in great heart having celebrated a centenary last year.

Over the decades it has been the centre of significant village gatherings, and appropriately houses the community World War I and II roles of honour.

The hall fell into disrepair and a group of passionate locals came together to save the valuable community asset. They formed an Incorporated Society, registered as a charity. Their efforts have given the hall a new lease of life as the hub of the community.



Fund raising activities and grants have enabled a number of restoration and repair projects to be completed.

Te Horo Country Market was first held in November 2012 as a hall fundraiser. The event was so successful it is held on the first Sunday of every month since. The doors are open from 10am until 12.30. The huge array of stalls offer all the usual country fare and much more.

Garden surplus is sold at the Seasonal Surplus Stall for a 20 percent donation of the sale price being given to the Hall fund, a Community Second Hand stall works on the same principle.
