## Memory Lane Museum

Step into a by-gone era and visit the Kapiti Coast Museum.

In the early 1980's a group of radio and telephone enthusiasts sought an appropriate place to house and display a collection of historical items. Waikanae Post Office, built in 1908, was available and ideal so the Waikanae Museum came into being in 1982. This evolved into the Kapiti Coast Museum in 1993.

Ever since, volunteers keep the wonderful little "time capsule" operating and open to the public Friday, Saturday and Sunday's from 1pm until 4pm excluding public holidays. There is no admission charge, but donations which keep the museum running, are always welcome.

Packed full of treasures which showcase the districts heritage, there is much to see. There are lovely old photographs showing familiar and not so familiar places and people, plus extraordinary exhibits which include vintage clothing, toys, musical instruments, Aunt Daisy's kitchen, static and interactive 'hands on' displays which are especially interesting for younger visitors.

Call in and browse a while. Better still become a member, and if you have a couple of hours to spare once a month consider becoming a volunteer.
