COMMUNITY LAW Caring for our Community

Horowhenua Community Law is there to help provide people with the information and support in order for them to make decisions regarding law related issues. They do this by providing a confidential service to the community at little or no cost to those who use it.

While some criteria does apply, the aim of HCL is to make their service easily accessible to all people in the community regardless of their circumstances, and to incorporate whanau ora principles, working alongside whanau ora partners to achieve this.

Community Law has been in New Zealand since 1978. Often confused with Legal Aid, where fees may need to be repaid, Community Law offers free assistance to eligible clients. The other main difference is that Community Law Centres are

independent charities, and although they receive Government funding, are not connected to the public service.

Community Law Horowhenua assists students, beneficiaries, unemployed or those on a low income, who are usually eligible for initial one-on-one legal help. Other people may also be eligible. People who are vulnerable such as having literacy issues, being homeless, transient, in a crisis living situation, from a refugee background, and/or adversely affected by disability, mobility issues, mental illness, or experiencing violence.

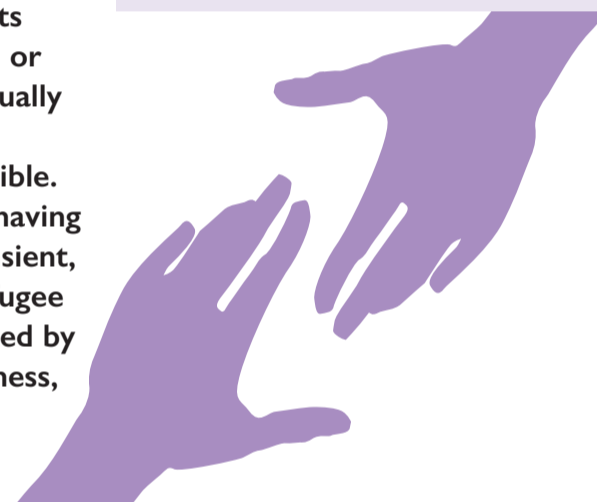
