During the Covid-19 lockdown did you wish you were computer savvy, or maybe more computer savvy? SeniorNet Kapiti is here to help.

Established in 1997, SeniorNet Kapiti is part of a national community training network open to people from 50 years of age. Their aim is to teach the necessary skills to make information technology (IT) accessible and easy, giving people the confidence to learn useful IT skills for every day life even if they have no computer experience.

Members had online courses during lockdown. They were taught to use "Zoom" for maintaining contact with loved ones. Online Q&A sessions, plus a one-on-one Helpdesk supported members when or if they encountered IT problems.



SeniorNet Kapiti Is IT (Information Technology) for you?

All tutors are volunteers, giving their time and expertise for free. They have a broad range of IT experience gained through their working life, or through SeniorNet training.

Members can attend small, friendly courses and workshops regularly. In most cases computers are provided in the course fees which range from \$10 for a one-off session or \$30 for a weekly session over five weeks. Workshops range from \$2 to \$5.



Topics offered include getting started with a laptop, PC, tablet or mobile phone, using the internet, creating documents, emailing, managing your photographs and data and much more.

Annual membership is \$30 for individuals, or \$50 per

couple, new members are always welcome.

Making the best of your hot water

Electra offers lower prices for allowing us to control your electric hot water during times of peak demand, we do this via a device attached to your meter board.

These prices are available because Electra is able to manage its peak demand Transpower transmission charges - and these savings are passed on to Electra customers.

Without load control, household power bills could rise.



During this time of year (but it can happen all year round) you might notice Electra enable Control of your electric hot water cylinders - generally between 7.30 and 9.30am and again between 5.30 and 8.30pm. In most cases you will not notice as hot water cylinders can hold their temperature for a long time.

If you notice a shortage of hot water outside the above times, we may have needed a longer control period or your hot water cylinder may be reheating.
