Kapiti Meals on Wheels is looking for more volunteer drivers to become part of a team delivering up to 2000 meals every month. Operating on weekdays, drivers give a few hours of their time on a weekly or fortnightly basis, taking mid-day meals to recipients in Raumati, Paraparaumu and Waikanae. Volunteers

do receive some assistance towards their running costs.

Some drivers have been supporting their clients for a matter of months while others have been helping for many years. On delivering the meal, they also provide recipients with regular contact and a friendly face. Volunteers are of all ages and enjoy their role in the local community, and members of one of the world's largest humanitarian organisations, New Zealand Red Cross.
