Members enjoy many services from help with photos enabling Super Gold Cards to be used as supporting identification with approved ID, card crafting classes, Strength and Balance Fall Prevention exercises and much more.

A visiting service for people who lack social contact or are faced with loneliness can include a 'Companion on Paw' service where volunteers bring their canine companion for a visit.

The 'Ageing Well Programme' offers company, trips away and general things to do with like minded people. The Health Promotion Service offers driver education, exercise and digital skills, information on nutrition and more. Free 'Total Mobility' eligibility assessments can be arranged, along with accessing Mobility Parking Permits.

A wide range of services which includes coordinating community support in cases of elder abuse, working alongside DHB's, Police, Social Workers and home-based support are provided in strict confidence.

The ACH are always open to suggestions of further things to help the seniors in our community.

THE DANGER THAT LURKS BELOW

Please be mindful of the hazard that exists when metal stakes are driven in an area where underground services may exist.

Consider using non metallic stakes, getting power cables located, and keeping temporary fencing and signage inside the boundary.
